Bertrand Russell Prize of the AMS

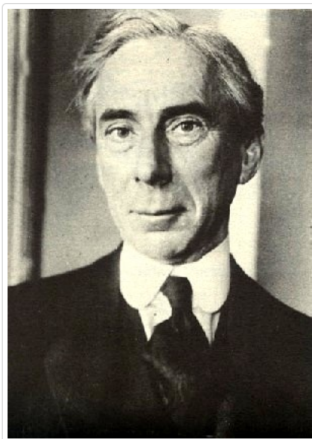

About this Prize

The Bertrand Russell Prize of the AMS was established in 2016 by Thomas Hales. The prize looks beyond the confines of the profession to research or service contributions of mathematicians or related professionals to promoting good in the world. It recognizes the various ways that mathematics furthers fundamental human values. Mathematical contributions that further world health, our understanding of climate change, digital privacy, or education in developing countries, are some examples of the type of work that might be considered for the prize.

In particular, through her visionary leadership of the thematic year *Mathematics of Planet Earth 2013* and her continuing active involvement in the ongoing activities that grew from it, Professor Rousseau has created opportunities for the mathematics community worldwide to confront crucial challenges facing our planet while highlighting the contributions of mathematicians to the well-being of society.

Through her commitment, dedication, energy, and ability, Professor Rousseau has mobilized mathematicians to take on world challenges, advancing the discipline and making her a most appropriate recipient of the first Bertrand Russell Prize of the AMS.
